MICHAEL LOFTIN | CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER

With over 35 years of experience in community and homeownership advocacy, Mike led the creation and implementation of Homewise's customer-centric, comprehensively integrated homeownership business model. More recently, he spearheaded the creation of Homewise's catalytic community development strategy to revitalize targeted disinvested neighborhoods in Albuquerque and create new mixed-use, mixed-income communities in Santa Fe.
